Undergraduate Fees Policy

TSIBA Business School, registered as TSIBA Education NPC, commits to the principles of inclusivity and access to quality higher education as a fundamental human right in alignment with the Global Sustainability Goals on Education.

Accordingly, to balance student affordability with the institution's ability to provide academic excellence and exceptional value through the full learning journey, undergraduate tuition fees at TSIBA Education are subsidised at an average of 65% of the cost of provisioning per student. The subsidies are funded by generous donors and philanthropists worldwide who actively invest in education and the future prosperity of South Africa and its people.

This subsidised model aims to provide inclusive access to academically rigorous, inclusive and premium business education from a highly qualified faculty in an environment built for both self-development and academic success.

Important Notes On Fees Payable

- A non-refundable **application fee** of R100,00 is required to process all applications for admission. This fee does not apply to semester 2 (mid-year) registrations.
- A non-refundable minimum initial payment (MIP) of R500,00 is payable on acceptance, to secure the admission. This payment is credited to the tuition fees on registration.
- **Monthly Instalment:** Fees are paid monthly in equal instalments over a ten (10) months with the first instalment payable by 28 February. The full fee account must be settled by 30 November of the respective academic year
- **Advance Payment:** Fees are discounted by 5% of the invoice value when 50% is paid at registration (or within 5 working days thereof) and the balance must be paid in equal instalments over ten (10) months by 30 November of the respective academic year.
- **Full Payment:** Fees are discounted by 10% when full payment of the invoice is made at registration (or within 5 working days thereof).
- A **10% fees discount** is provided on full upfront payment of the PGDBA programme.
- TSIBA Alumni receive **discounted fees** on the PGDBA Qualification.
- Failure to settle the tuition fees will result in withholding academic results and the student not being registered for the next semester, or graduating.
- TSIBA Education has agreements with Student Hero for financing tuition fees. Students may also explore financing with any other financial institutions of choice.
- All full-time undergraduate students may apply for available bursaries and scholarships.
